



## **TELEGRAPH COVE MARINA & RV PARK (TCM)**

### **ON-SITE POLICIES 2019**

*To our valued guests: For your safety and enjoyment, please read and comply with the following policies.*

**Check in:** 2:00 pm, **Check out:** 11 am (RV sites and Marina)

- All vehicles must have a parking permit clearly visible on the dashboard.
- All boat trailers must have a parking permit clearly visible on the winch.
- All pets must be on leash and must be kept quiet so as not to disturb other guests. Please clean up after your pets. For your convenience waste bag stations are located around the site.
- *Quiet Hours* are between 10 pm and 7 am.
- TCM will not be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of any boat or personal property while moored, parked or visiting the premises.
- You are responsible for any damages you or one of your party causes to the premises.
- All water at the Marina and RV park is pure drinking water. Clean water is a precious commodity; please conserve.
- Please vacate site/slip on time to avoid inconveniencing guests that will be checking in. Violation of check out time may result in additional charges or removal of unit or vessel at owner's expense.
- Office hours are 9 am to 5 pm

#### **RV PARK**

- **Avoid backing into water hydrants located at each RV site.** Always use a spotter when backing into RV spaces and when opening an RV slide out. Damage to RV sites (water stands, electrical connections, etc.) will be charged to credit card number on file.
- Do not occupy or block any other RV space without prior permission.
- No parking or driving over grass areas without prior permission.
- When using the fire pits, please use the fire screens.
- RV Park rates are based on one RV, tent, camper or trailer per site with double occupancy (2 adults)

#### **MARINA**

- Use and occupy marina floats at your own risk.
- Vessels including bow pulpits, motors and other attachments must fit **entirely** within the assigned slip.
- Park only in your assigned slip.
- **No smoking is allowed on the boardwalk or marina floats.**
- Children must wear life jackets on the floats and be under the constant supervision of an adult.
- Fish cleaning stations are provided at the end of A, B and C docks. Please clean up after use. Do not clean fish in unauthorized locations.
